With what shall I come before the Lord...

He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.

Micah 6:8

No doubt many of you have heard of great Indigenous leaders such as William Cooper, David Unaipon and Pastor Sir Doug Nicholls. We are familiar with these men for their work for Indigenous rights in the late 1800s. They spoke out about the treatment of our people and after seeing the injustices done, sought to put things right.

Much of the growth, development, and progress of Indigenous Australians in this country, came about through the work of such men and women. What is lesser known, and not spoken about, is that these men were Christians. It was these men who were willing to Get Up, Stand Up and Show Up driven by their Christian convictions regarding what God called them to do.

During this same period, William (Bill) Ferguson was a man who was also driven by his strong Christian convictions. Bill was the grandfather of Field Staff George Ferguson. It was due to Bill's influence that George and other members of his family came to faith in Jesus.

Bill Ferguson was born at Darlington Point, NSW, and grew up at the Warangesda Aboriginal Mission near Cootamundra. Much of his childhood was spent helping his father in the shearing sheds. Later in life Bill became a mailman in western NSW.

Bill was married to Margaret and was instrumental in setting up the 'Aboriginal Progressive Association.' He, along with John Patten, organised the first day of mourning on Australia Day 1938.

Like Cooper, Unaipon and Nicholls, Ferguson was also driven by his strong Christian convictions.


These godly men brought about change for Indigenous people in this country. Driven by their love for God and love for their people, they lived out the Scriptures in seeking justice for them. While much of the church has failed in some areas of living out Micah 6:8, Indigenous Christian men and women were instrumental in providing the leadership that was necessary to bring about justice and change for our people.
