## Going the distance indeed!

I remember well sitting around the boardroom table in the National Office as the Executive were presented with drawings of proposed changes to the BCA logo and style. There was a growing anticipation of what such changes could generate as we focused on 'Going the distance'. Jesus also gave a similar call recorded in Matthew 7: 7, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.". After I retired a whole new chapter in my BCA involvement opened before me. I had more time for prayer and what a privilege that is.

There are times, unknown to us, when Field or Administration staff are facing tough situations. A parent or child is sick, and in isolated locations that can become complicated. Maybe an accident has happened involving a parishioner or member of staff. Although transport has improved in recent decades, there are still frustrations to face in waiting for parts or repairs, especially if the washing machine, fridge, air conditioner, or car is involved. Friendships for children can become an issue in small communities as they repeatedly find themselves forced to find new friends as families leave town. If it happens too often, relationship complications can arise. There is the scorching dry heat in Alice Springs and Roxby Downs. While in Kununurra, Darwin and other places, as the Watson family reminded us in December that summer can be exhausting, "as build-up weather fatigue sets in and life is very full, please pray for extra strength for us..." These Prayer Notes are a treasure because they help us to uphold before the Lord members of the team each day.

We are also privileged because we share in the joys and celebrations. The news that a parish camp was such a blessing, that a Scripture lesson in school opened new understandings, or a comment made in Bible Study revealed the Holy Spirit at work. It declares that the words of Jesus in John 15:5 are true, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.". What an exciting and privileged team to be part of in the service of the Lord.
